Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I was expecting to have another week with Father Crispine, but sorrowful circumstances altered those plans. I could not say a proper “goodbye” to him and maybe you also. Some of you may recall that Father John left rather abruptly in February 2017 after being called to fill a vacant position at St Boniface in Evansville. Thus, we were without a pastor for two months when Father Crispine arrived introducing himself to us at Mass saying he was sorry for his accent. It came from Kentucky, which, brought laughter and that was the beginning of his stay with us. From then on, a friendship developed that will last many years. We hope you will remember us for many years too Father Crispine!

At the same time, I want to say, “Welcome, Father Martin!” I hope and pray your stay at our parish will be fruitful for your priestly ministry. Please allow some time for us to grieve Father Crispine leaving, and yet rejoice at your presence here. Perhaps, you too will be grieving the friends you left behind at Holy Rosary. But, God bless you for saying “yes” to our parish.

Today, we celebrate Father’s Day. I hope you have fond memories of your father. These are a few things I remember of dad: His hands seem to fit naturally onto the handle of a shovel, a hammer, or pliers. Dad’s hands were always dirty and calloused or so it seemed. A time or two he smashed a finger, yet not a bad word uttered we heard. He laid twenty thousand feet of clay tile, not with machine, but with a shovel. Making and building things were not the only things dad’s hands touched. He was the discipliner in our family. But we knew where he stood. Always ready to play a game of euchre. His big calloused hands held us from the first moments we began to breathe into our tiny lungs. Growing ever larger, his hands caught us when jumping up to have our heads rest on his shoulder. My father’s hands caressed us, changed us, and carried us. But soon enough our hands grew to where he could not engulf them, only to clasp them. My father was battered by our excuses and failures. Yet, he endured them knowing they were not permanent dispositions patiently accepting them as crosses that go with the position. Once, I saw dad openly cry in his life. It was the death of his sister whom he had just visited moments before. Though Alzheimer’s claimed his memory, it did not claim our memory of him. I hope and pray you too can celebrate Father’s Day thanking him for all the things he has taught and may still be teaching you.
