We are on the Third Sunday of Easter. The risen Christ appears to the Apostles with a presence other than what he was in his mortal life. The apostles are surprised at Jesus' sudden appearance, his brief and substantial messages, and his goodbye. The light of the Resurrection helps them to understand the scriptures - the bread at Emmaus and the fish in Jerusalem make their presence tangible, and especially given the gift of peace as the fruit of the Redemption.

Easter has real consequences in our lives: It leads us to accept that Christ is risen and has dramatically defeated the evil in this world. It's true that Easter is joy and poetry, but also commitment. Sin is always going to be there, inside and outside us. To celebrate Easter means that we believe in the risen Christ and will sin no more. We must choose to live the law of the commandments and lead a new life of justice and charity. The question is whether this experience of the encounter with the risen Christ is clearly lived in our daily lives. Easter is not an anniversary. It is a grace, a path that we are committed to. It is time to recall our own baptism and the joy of dying with Christ and hope of rising with him on the last day.

There are so many preparations going on especially with the First Holy Communion coming on the 28th of April. These are special moments for our children and also exciting times as we the adults recall when we first experience Jesus in the Eucharist, eating his body and drinking his blood. May we continue to grow in our faith and to help these children, our gifts from God to grow closing to him daily in life through the sacraments.
